



## Application for WACE recognition of a VET accredited course

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School Code

An accredited course is one that is developed to meet training needs not addressed by existing training packages. Courses and modules that are not part of a nationally endorsed training package do not automatically provide students with recognition towards the WACE.

This application is for schools who wish to enrol students in a VET accredited course that is not currently listed on the Accredited Course Recognition Status list which is available on the WACE Recognition of VET Accredited Courses webpage on the Authority website

The provision of the appropriate level of recognition for VET accredited courses is determined based on the classification of the course outcomes. The classification scheme determines whether the accredited course outcomes have an industry, foundation skills or vocational focus. If an accredited course is approved for WACE recognition then the successful completion will be awarded credit as unit equivalents towards achievement of the WACE, in the same manner as nationally endorsed training package VET qualifications. Not all accredited courses approved for WACE recognition can contribute to meeting the Certificate II minimum requirement however.
