Year 12 students who were enrolled in three or fewer Stage 2 and/or Stage 3 paired units, and who were enrolled in VET units of competency (from related industry areas) in excess of 220 nominal hours that led to achievement in full or partial qualifications in the year they were completing the WACE requirements were exempt from sitting the Stage 3 examination. Year 12 students who were enrolled in a pair of examinable Stage 2 course units could have opted out of sitting the WACE examination for that course.
