In recent years candidates have mostly lost marks because they took their mobile phones into an examination. No responsibility will be accepted by the supervisor for your property.

By now your school will have provided you with information about the examination process. You would have been told that if you are affected by a temporary sickness or misadventure during the exams, you should make a sickness/misadventure application. Information about sickness/misadventure can be found in the <u>Year 12 Information Handbook</u> on page 34.
