If taught in Years 9 or 10, reporting is mandatory .

Languages	LLAN	Reporting is mandatory for Years 3 to 8 for at least one language. The subject codes for each language and sequence can be found in the table on the following pages. Reporting is optional for Pre-primary, but mandatory for Years 3 to 8. If taught in Years 1, 2, 9 or 10, reporting is mandatory .

The Arts	LART	It is mandatory to report achievements against both the Performance Arts and Visual Arts subjects. Achievements must be reported against at least one Performance Arts subject (DANP, DRAP, MUSP) and at least one Visual Arts subject (VARV, MEDV). Reporting is optional for Pre-primary, but mandatory for Years 1 to 8. If taught in Years 9 or 10, reporting is mandatory .

Reporting student achievement to the Authority

Student achievement is reported on a five-point scale as either a letter grade or the equivalent achievement descriptor: (A = Excellent, B = High, C = Satisfactory, D = Limited, E = Very Low). Where an achievement descriptor is required, an Authority-approved system-based or school-based achievement descriptor may be used.

- For Pre-primary, schools report achievement descriptors **without** letter grades.
- For Years 1–2, schools report letter grades **or** achievement descriptors.
- For Years 3–10, schools report letter grades **without** achievement descriptors.
