



Reporting P–10 Achievements

The *Pre-primary to Year 10: Teaching, Assessing and Reporting Policy* (<https://k10outline.scsa.wa.edu.au/home/policy/teaching-assessing-and-reporting-policy>) (the Policy) sets out the minimum mandatory requirements for curriculum planning, assessment and reporting on student achievement. The following table must be read in conjunction with the Policy and the *Policy Standards for Pre-primary to Year 10: Teaching, Assessing and Reporting* (the Policy Standards).

Explanatory Notes

Learning Area	When schools are reporting:
LENG	English , the code will be LENG . This is Mandatory for all Year levels (PP to Year 10).
LMAT	Mathematics , the code will be LMAT . This is Mandatory for all Year levels (PP to Year 10).
LSCI	Science , the code will be LSCI . Reporting is Optional for PP, but Mandatory for Years 1 to 10.
LHSS	Humanities and Social Sciences , the code will be LHSS . Reporting is Optional for PP, but Mandatory for Years 1 to 10.
LHPE	Health and Physical Education , achievements are reported against two codes HED and PED . Reporting is Optional for PP, but Mandatory for Years 1 to 10.
LTEC*	Technologies , it is Mandatory to report achievements against both (Curriculum Area) – Design and Technology (DAT) and Digital Technology (DIT). However, under DAT , achievements may alternatively be reported against context/s: DATES, DATFF, DATFS, DATMT . Reporting is Optional for Pre-primary, Year 9 and Year 10, but Mandatory for Years 1 to 8.
LLAN*	Languages , reporting is Mandatory for Year 3 to Year 8, in at least one language: Code will be relevant to the language and the language sequence taught and assessed. Reporting is Optional for Pre-primary to Year 2 and Years 9 and 10.
LART*	The Arts , it is Mandatory to report achievements against both (Curriculum Area) – Performance Arts and Visual Arts. Achievements must be reported against at least one Performance Arts subject (DANP, DRAP, MUSP) and at least one Visual Arts subject (VARV, MEDV). Reporting is Optional for Pre-primary and Years 9 and 10.

* Where teaching is Optional, if taught, reporting is Mandatory.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Achievement of what is expected at this academic year level: A=Excellent, B=High, C=Satisfactory, D=Limited, E=Very low (or an equivalent five point scale/achievement descriptor). Note: Pre-primary use achievement descriptors and without letter grades. For Years 1–2, student achievement is reported using system-based or school-based achievement descriptors. Schools may use letter grades. For Years 3–10, letter grades and achievement descriptors must be used. 	
LENG	Schools report one grade (A–E) for English
LMAT	Schools report one grade (A–E) for Mathematics
LSCI	Schools report one grade (A–E) for Science
LHSS	Schools report one grade (A–E) for Humanities and Social Sciences
HED/PED	Schools report one grade (A–E) for Health Education and one grade (A–E) for Physical Education
DAT/DIT	Schools report one grade (A–E) for DAT , but may alternatively report against the context/s and one grade (A–E) for DIT .
Language Code	Schools report one grade (A–E) for each Language delivered = ALT, ARA, AUS, CHI, CLF, FRE, GER, HEB, HIN, IND, ITA, JAP, KOR, GRE, SPA, TAM, TUR, VIE
PAR/VAR	Schools report one grade (A–E) for Performance Arts and one grade (A–E) for Visual Arts in one or more subjects.
