



Explanation of changes to the *2023 Activities Schedule*

The following changes for *2023 Activities Schedule* should be noted.

Term weeks are indicated in this schedule on the basis of dates associated with student attendance. Each term in 2023 is of 10 weeks duration (as they were in 2022).

Notes:

- NAPLAN tests are from Wednesday, 15 to Monday, 27 March 2023 (instead of being administered in May, as was the case in 2022).
- OLNA will now be available on multiple occasions throughout the year.
- Transfer of registration and demographic information to Brightpath will happen more frequently than in 2022.
- The delivery of externally set tasks (ESTs) by schools has been scheduled for Weeks 3, 4 and 5 in Term 2 (commencing a week later than in 2022).
- A Common Oral Assessment Task (COAT) for the Year 12 ATAR EAL/D course has been introduced to replace the EAL/D practical examination.
- Changes have been made to course details –
 - a. Media Production and Analysis no longer has stimulus materials for the written examination.
 - b. English as an Additional Language or Dialect no longer has an ATAR course practical examination.
