We write regarding our shared commitment to prevent, tackle, and respond to antisemitism, and strengthen social cohesion across Australia's education system.

The Australian Government committed to establishing the Social Cohesion Education Hub (the Hub) in December 2025 as part of its response to the Plan to Combat Antisemitism, led by Australia's Special Envoy to Combat Antisemitism. At the February 2026 Education Ministers Meeting, Ministers agreed to establish the Hub to support educators and education communities to strengthen social cohesion.

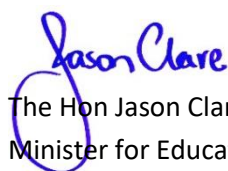
The Hub provides teachers, school leaders, early childhood educators and communities with access to free, quality assured online resources, professional learning, and practical guidance. It brings together existing resources in one place to support educators in fostering safe, inclusive and respectful learning environments, and responding effectively to incidents of discrimination.

The Hub is now available at www.socialcohesionhub.edu.au. This is the first phase of a staged national rollout. Additional materials will continue to be added in response to identified gaps, emerging needs, and ongoing jurisdictional and stakeholder feedback.

Please visit the Hub, explore the initial suite of existing resources, and consider how they may be applied in classrooms, early childhood services and education communities. We encourage you to share this letter, and the enclosed information on the Hub, with your colleagues and community.

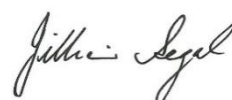
